- 1 The bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using nondiscretionary "pass/fail" criteria as specified in the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 (R.A. 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act." The same law shall also govern all other particulars relative to the bidding.
- Approved Budget for the Contract: P3,000,000.00

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→ NOTE: Late bids are <u>automatically</u> disqualified;

• Prospective bidders shall submit their bids, on or before the deadline<sup>2</sup>, through their duly authorized representative/s in two (2) separate sealed envelopes<sup>3</sup>:

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Any price offer that exceeds the ABC for a particular lot shall be <u>automatically</u> disqualified (Sec.31.1, Revised IRR); only bids that are within the ABC per lot may be considered for award if proven to be the lowest calculated and responsive bid among all other bids.

- The **first** shall contain the eligibility requirements (legal, technical, and financial documents); and
- The **second** shall contain the financial information or the bid price, with the name of the contract to be bid and the name and address of the prospective bidder in capital letters, addressed to the ECC-BAC. The bidder shall mark the two envelopes: "Do not open before (date and time of opening of bids)." The first envelope must have corresponding tabs
  - <sup>2</sup> Bids must be submitted on or before 1:30 p.m.; the official clock would be at the 4th floor of the ECC Bldg.
  - <sup>3</sup> The prospective bidder must <u>submit three (3) sets of documents</u> required in the first and second envelopes.

### FIRST ENVELOPE (must contain the following):

#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

#### I. Class "A" Documents

#### A. LEGAL DOCUMENTS

- Registration Certificate from SEC, DTI [for sole proprietorship], or CDA [for cooperatives], whichever is applicable;
- Current Mayor's Permit issued by the city or municipality where the principal place of business of the prospective bidder is located;
- Tax Clearance:
- Current PhilGeps Certificate (Platinum);

#### B. TECHNICAL DOCUMENTS

- Statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing and completed<sup>4</sup> government and private contracts, including awarded but not yet started, if any, between 2018 and 2019.
  - <sup>4</sup> The prospective bidder **must have completed at least a single similar contract** between 2018 and 2019 must be at least 50% of the ABC.
- Statement of the bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC), similar to the contract to be bid, between 2018 and 2019.

#### C. FINANCIAL DOCUMENTS

 The prospective bidder's audited financial statements, showing, among others, the prospective bidder's total and current assets and

- liabilities, stamped "received" by the BIR or its duly accredited and authorized institutions for the year 2018;
- The prospective bidder's computation for its Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) or a commitment from a Universal or Commercial Bank to extend a credit line in favor of the prospective bidder if awarded the contract to be bid.

#### II. Class "B" Documents

- Valid joint venture agreement (if applicable).
- The **BID SECURITY** (Sec. 27.2, RIIR) as to form, amount and validity period. The required amount of the above forms of security shall be in accordance with the following schedule:

d. Bid Securing Declaration (GPPB Resolution No. 03-2012, 27 January 2012)	No percentage required

- **SWORN STATEMENT** by the prospective bidder or its duly authorized representative as to the following:
  - It is not "blacklisted" or barred from bidding by the government or any of its agencies, offices, corporations, or Local Government units including foreign government/foreign or international financing institution whose blacklisting rules have been recognized by the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPBB);
  - 2. Each of the documents submitted in satisfaction of the bidding requirements is an authentic copy of the original complete, and all statements and information provided therein are true and correct;
  - 3. It is authorizing the Head of the Procuring Entity or his duly authorized representative/s to verify all the documents submitted;
  - 4. The signatory is the duly authorized representative of the prospective bidder, and granted full power and authority to do, execute and perform any and all acts necessary and/or to represent the prospective bidder in the bidding with the duly notarized Secretary's Certificate attesting to

- such fact, if the prospective bidder is a corporation, partnership, cooperative, or joint venture;
- 5. It complies with the disclosure provision under Sec. 47 of R.A. 9184<sup>5</sup>. The said section reads:
  - "Sec. 47. Disclosure of Relations. In addition to the proposed contents of the Invitation to Bid as mentioned under Section 21 of this Act, all bidding documents shall be accompanied by a sworn affidavit of the bidder that he or she or any officer of their corporation is not related to the Head of the Procuring Entity by consanguinity or affinity up to the third civil degree. Failure to comply with the aforementioned provision shall be a ground for the automatic disqualification of the bid in consonance with Section 30 of this Act."
    - In accordance with Section 47 of the IRR of RA 9184, all Bidding Documents shall be accompanied by a sworn affidavit of the Bidder that it is not related to the Head of the Procuring Entity, members of the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), members of the Technical Working Group (TWG), members of the BAC Secretariat, the head of the Project Management Office (PMO) or the end-user unit, and the project consultants, by consanguinity or affinity up to the third-civil degree. On the part of the Bidder, this Clause shall apply to the following persons:
      - (a) If the Bidder is an individual or a sole proprietorship, to the Bidder himself:
      - (b) If the Bidder is a partnership, to all its officers and members;
      - (c) If the Bidder is a corporation, to all its officers, directors, and controlling stockholders; and
      - (d) If the Bidder is a joint venture (JV), the provisions of items (a), (b), or (c) of this Clause shall correspondingly apply to each of the members of the said JV, as may be appropriate.
      - (e) If the Bidder is a joint venture (JV), the provisions of items (a), (b), or (c) of this Clause shall correspondingly apply to each of the members of the said JV, as may be appropriate.

Relationship of the nature described above or failure to comply with this Clause will result in the automatic disqualification of a Bidder [4.2 (a)-(d), Philippine Bidding Documents, Procurement of Goods].

- 6. It complies with the responsibilities of a prospective or eligible bidder provided in the PBDs.<sup>6</sup>
  - <sup>6</sup> a. Having taken steps to carefully examine all of the Bidding Documents;
    - b. Having acknowledged all conditions, local or otherwise, affecting the implementation of the contract;
    - c. Having made an estimate of the facilities available and needed for the contract to be bid, if any; and
    - d. Having complied with its responsibility to inquire or secure Supplemental Bid Bulletin/s.

Failure to observe any of the above responsibilities shall be at the risk of the Bidder concerned (6.2 (a)- (i), Philippine Bidding Documents).

- 7. It complies with prevailing labor and social security (SSS, EC, Philhealth, and PAG-IBIG) laws, rules, and regulations.
- 8. It did not give or pay, directly or indirectly, any commission, amount fee, or any form of consideration, pecuniary or otherwise, to any person or official, personnel or representative of the government in relation to any procurement project or activity.
