Asset Management System (AMS) – Not Acceptable The ECC contended that an amendment to the ISSP was made to prioritize a more important related system – Supply and Property Management System (SPMS), and that the DICT failed to respond to or grant clearance for its request. A careful review of ECC's correspondence with the DICT revealed that the letter has made no reference to any modifications or amendments related to the AMS. Moreover, ECC did not provide sufficient documents to justify its assertions regarding the causes of the system's procurement delays. Thus, ECC's claims remain uncorroborated and lack persuasive merit.
